



# Lydden Hill Race Circuit COVID-19 Regulations

*5 Nations British Rallycross Championship 30-31 August*

Please take a moment to read through the various measures we have put in place with regards to keeping everyone here at the track safe from COVID-19. These have been put together with the help from our health and safety teams, Motorsport UK, insurance company and governing bodies.

This is a trying time for us all and the safety of everyone here at Lydden is paramount, please understand that we are opening the track to spectators for the very first time since the virus hit and our aim is for everyone to have a great weekend of rallycross all while keeping safe.

If you need any clarification with regards to the below, please don't hesitate to get in touch.

- Go home if you, or anyone in your household, have any symptoms of Covid-19, or if you feel unwell while you at the track.
- Social interactions must be limited, for the moment this is between two households.
- Do not interact with any outside of your group and try to keep 2 meters away from anyone that you do not live with.
- Please pay attention to all signage on site. If you are seen not adhering the Covid 19 guidelines you will be sent home.
- A queuing system is in place for toilets and a limited number of people may enter at one time. Signage is present for this.
- We will ensure toilets are cleaned frequently and our new Covid-secure cleaning rosters have been implemented to include things like frequent cleaning of door handles.
- Hand sanitising bays will be available around the venue – These will be marked out by 'Sanitising Station' signage. Please ensure you wash your hands regularly.
- Grandstands are off limits at this time.
- Please put all your tissues in the bins provided around site.

## **Children**

- Parents are responsible for ensuring children comply with Covid-19 precautions and regulations.

## **Face Masks**

We suggest that all spectators wear face masks during attendance at the event. Face masks are mandatory for certain areas, such as the paddock walk-through, catering facilities and toilets.

## **Paddock**

The paddock area is closed to the public. You may walk through the designated walk-way.

Please keep left at all times and do not stop to look at any vehicles or talk to the competitors.

Masks are mandatory at this point for everyone. If you cannot wear a face mask for health reasons, for the protection of competitors and their crews, we cannot allow you in this area.

MSUK have worked hard to get motorsport restarted so if we feel that we are at risk of compromising their efforts then this area will be shut.

## **Catering**

- There are additional catering units for spectators as the paddock unit will not be available.
- A queuing system will be in place for the catering unit (1m distance as well as the use of face masks)
- Our staff will be behind Perspex screens and will be wearing the appropriate PPE.
- Card and contactless payments only.
- Takeaway facilities only.

## **Camping**

- Campers must not interact with anyone outside of their bubble.
- Please ensure your camping band is on your wrist and visible at all times. This will allow us to monitor from a distance.
- Showers will remain closed.
